Dear Student,

For those progressing from the CertHE/1st year to the 2nd year of the LL. B and also from the 2nd year to the 3rd year of the LL. B, lecturers will commence on Saturday, 27 August 2022 at 9 a.m. Lecturers will be held virtually on MICROSOFT TEAMS.

Your timetable is attached herewith for your information and it will also be posted on the CfPS Course Web. Your user name and password will be given to you on the payment of the CfPS course fees as indicated below in this letter. Please also submit to us the duly completed continuing registration form attached herewith on or before September 17th 2022.

Please note the following:

1. Students registered under the Certificate of Higher Education in Common Law programme (CertHE) and LL. B Standard entry route (1st YEAR)

For those progressing from the CertHE programme to the 2nd year and also for those LL.B. 1st year students who wish to follow the 2nd year **LL. B** programme, lecturers will be conducted on Saturday and Sunday.

Students registered under the LL. B programme needs to pass 2 modules including LSM to progress into the 2nd year of the LL. B

Students registered under the CertHE programme need to pass 3 modules including LSM to progress into the 2nd year of the LL. B

You need to pass Legal System and Method (LSM) to progress into the 2nd year of the LL. B (or need to register concurrently along with the 2nd year subjects.)

In the 2nd year of the LL. B you are required to follow one compulsory module and three optional modules from the level 5 category. The compulsory module is **Tort Law**.

3. Students registered under the LL. B Standard entry route (2nd YEAR)

For those progressing from the 2nd year into the 3rd or final year of study, lecturers' will be conducted on Saturday and Sunday.

Students need to pass 2 modules to progress into the 3rd year of the LL.B. You are also required to pass Tort Law and all the four modules of the 1st year in order to progress into the 3rd year of the LL. B

In the 3rd year of the LL.,B you are required to follow one compulsory module and three optional modules from the level 6 category. The compulsory subject is **Jurisprudence and Legal Theory**.

The Standard entry students can sit for **five** modules in their **final year of study**.

4. Students re-sitting for a paper in October 2022 (Re-sit exam).

Students are permitted to re-sit for two papers in October 2022.

If you were unable to sit for exams in May 2022 due to the situation the Country was facing at that time and if you had informed, your difficulties to the UOL you will be able to sit for assessments in October 2022 in the maximum number of modules you are eligible to be assessed in for this academic year. The usual maximum of two modules in October will not apply to you.

Students intending to sit for their examinations in October 2022 will be able to complete their continuing registration with the UOL only after their October results are released in December 2022.

5. Students registered under the graduate entry route (currently holding a degree from a recognised University)

- (a) If you are a student on the graduate entry route and if you have passed a minimum of two Modules in the 1st year you can progress into the 2nd year of your LL.B. if you have passed four Modules in the 1st year you could progress into the final year of the LL. B and you are permitted to sit for five modules and complete the LL. B degree.
- (b) You are required to follow Jurisprudence and Legal Theory (compulsory subject) and chose two optional subjects from Level Five and chose two optional subjects from Level Six.

6. Qualifying Law Degree (QLD)

Please note that students who wish to register for the Qualifying law degree (QLD) are required to sit for the four compulsory modules listed below in their 2nd and 3rd year of study.

1. Tort law
2. Property Law
3. EU Law
4. Equity and Trust

7. The optional subjects available to you at CfPS Law School are

- *Administrative law*
 - *Commercial Law*
 - *EU Law*
 - *Property Law*
 - *International Protection of Human Rights*
- } Level 5
- *Company Law*
 - *Intellectual Property Law (IP)*
 - *Equity and Trust*
 - *Public International Law (PIL)*
 - *Criminology*
- } Level 6

Please note that the optional modules are segregated into level 5 and level 6. Students in their 2nd year of study need to select their optional modules only from level 5.

Students in their 3rd year of study need to select their optional modules only from level 6.

8. Fees

The fees for the second and third years are payable in two instalments. The continuing registration fee and the 1st instalment have to be paid at the commencement of the programme and the 2nd instalment needs to be paid on or before December 1st 2022.

Please refer to the fees structure for the academic year 2022/2023 posted on the CfPS course web.
